

Theodore (Ted) V. Griffin, 67

Theodore "Ted" V. Griffin, 67, of East Jordan, died Saturday, Oct. 31, 1992, at Northern Michigan Hospital in Petoskey, following an extended illness.

Funeral will be held on Wednesday, Nov. 4, at 11 a.m. at the Paullin Funeral Home in East Jordan with the Rev. Father William McKeon officiating. Interment will be at Sunset Hill Cemetery, East Jordan.

Mr. Griffin was born April 22, 1925 to George M. and Helen M. (La Pine) Griffin Sr., in Roseville.

Mr. Griffin had been a resident of East Jordan since 1985 moving from Union Lake. He was raised on Mackinac Island and moved to Farmington in 1940, then to Union Lake in 1962.

He was a veteran of World War II and a member of the American Legion Post No. 227. He was employed as a bricklayer and a member of bricklayers and allied craftsmen local No. 2 of Detroit for 40 years. He was a life member of

the National Rifle Association since 1966.

Mr. Griffin enjoyed hunting, fishing and watching Little League ball games. He especially enjoyed Halloween, giving away pencils, pens and candy.

He was preceded in death by a sister, Ann R. Kamradt and a brother, Peter R. Griffin.

Survivors include two brothers, George M. Griffin Jr. and John L. Griffin, both of Boyne City; one sister, Pauline E. Griffin of Southfield; and two nieces and five nephews.
