Charles J. Kortman, 88, of East Jordan, died Nov. 25, 1986, at Grandvue Medical Care Facility, East Jordan.

Funeral will be 2 p.m. Wednesday, Nov. 26 at St. Josephs Church, East Jordan. The Rev. Arthur Mulka will officiate and burial will be in Sunset Hill Cemetery, East Jordan.

Mr. Kortman was born Nov. 28, 1897, in New York, N.Y., the son of James and Margaret (Nebel) Kortman. He grew up in Bregenfield, N.J., and attended Columbia University.

On March 14, 1929, he married the former Mary E. Furlotte in a Montreal cathedral.
