Harold E. McFarland, 80, of Charlevoix, died Sept. 21, 1987, at Little Traverse Division, Northern Michigan Hospitals.

Cremation has taken place and graveside service will be 1 p.m. Friday, Sept. 25, at Sunset Hill Cemetery, East Jordan. The Rev. Robert Bellairs of the Barnard United Methodist Church will officiate.

Mr. McFarland was born Nov. 6, 1906, at Forent, Ontario, Canada, the son of Robert and Mary (Brush) McFarland. He came to the United States as a young man and was a barber at the former Pantlind Hotel in Grand Rapids for many years. He had resided in Charlevoix since 1980.
