Shirley E. Dolezel, 75, of East Jordan, died May 20, 1995, at Charlevoix Area Hospital.

Funeral was 11 a.m. today, May 23, at the Paullin Funeral Home in East Jordan. The Rev. William McKeon of St. Joseph Catholic Church in East Jordan officiated. Interment will take place in Sunset Hill Cemetery, East Jordan.

She was born Dec. 15, 1919, in East Jordan, the daughter of Christopher and Lillian (Mayville) Bulow. She grew up in East Jordan.
