Lawrence A. Schumacher, 85, of East Jordan, died Sunday, Dec. 1, 2002, at Grandvue Medical Care Facility in East Jordan.

Funeral services will be held 2 p.m. Wednesday, Dec. 4, 2002, at the Evangelical Lutheran Church in East Jordan. The Rev. Robert H. Quarter will officiate. Interment will be in Sunset Hill Cemetery in East Jordan.

He was born on Oct. 29, 1917, in Hazel Park, the son of Charles and Elvieda (Witt) Schumacher. He served in the United States Navy during World War II. On Sept. 30, 1939, in Centerline, Mich., he married Shirley Simons. She preceded him in death on Dec. 19, 1984. On Oct. 14, 1989 in East Jordan, he married Beatrice Family Patterson. She also preceded him in death on Nov. 26, 1990.

He was an artist who had worked as a sign painter and carpenter. He was a member of the Evangelical

Lutheran Church in East Jordan. He was a member of the Lutheran Brotherhood. He was active in the Portside Art Fair in East Jordan for many years.

Lawrence is survived by four children, Larry (Charlene) Schumacher of Kalkaska, Darrel (Janet) Schumacher of South Lyon, Marty Schumacher of East Jordan and Beth Ann Schumacher of Minneapolis; six grandchildren; seven great-grandchildren; and two sisters, Grace Redmer of East Jordan and Doris Lawrence of Hazel Park. He was also preceded in death by an infant child, Sonny Jean Schumacher, and one brother, Bud Schumacher.
