B. Rosetta "Rose" Boring, 82, of East Jordan, died Sept. 3, 1994, at home.

Funeral will be 11 a.m. Wednesday, Sept. 7, at the East Jordan Missionary Church, with the Rev. Peter Elliott officiating. Interment will be in Sunset Hill Cemetery, East Jordan.

She was born Jan. 16, 1912, at the family homestead in Echo Township, Antrim County, the daughter of Delbert "Bert" and Lylia (MacMillan) Bennett. She attended the Vance Country School until eighth grade and then three years at East Jordan High School. She spent her senior year at Detroit Northeastern High School and graduated in 1928. She attended Bethel College for three years and one year at Eastern Michigan University, where she earned a bachelor of science degree in 1964.

On May 16, 1931, she married Orrie Boring in Detroit. He preceded her in death on July 19, 1947.

Mrs. Boring taught in public schools for one year in South Lyon, one year in Ellsworth, and 12 years in Alpena. She retired from teaching

in 1977.

Mrs. Boring was a member of the Michigan Education Association and a charter member of the East Jordan Missionary Church.

She enjoyed reading, her church, and her family.

Survivors include one son, Bryan Boring and his wife, Janet, of Eastport; two daughters, Mary Bowring, and Barbara Harchis and her husband, Roger, all of East Jordan; 13 grandchildren; 22 great-grandchildren; two brothers, William Bennett and his wife, Lillian, of East Jordan, and Robert Bennett of Livonia; three sisters, Doris Petrie of East Jordan, Lucille Nowland of Detroit, and Helen Hazelmyer of East Jordan. In addition to her husband, Mrs. Boring was preceded in death by her parents; a son, David, in 1943; twin grandsons in 1990; a brother, George Bennett, in 1974; and a sister, Erma Kraemer, in 1989.
