Eva E. Brighton, 87, of East Jordan, died Dec. 30, 1993, at E.W. Sparrow Hospital in Lansing.

Funeral was held 1 p.m. Saturday at the Paullin Funeral Home in East Jordan. The Rev. Merlin K. Delo of the East Jordan United Methodist Church officiated. Burial will be in Sunset Hill Cemetery, East Jordan.

Mrs. Brighton was born July 13, 1906, in Sturgeon Bay, Bliss, the daughter of Cole H. and Margaret J. (Richardson) Campbell.

On April 19, 1924, she married Howard Brighton in Jackson. She and her family moved to Roscommon in 1943 and owned several businesses, including the Roscommon Shell station and restaurant. She was a long-time owner and
