Funeral services for Mrs. Gladys Davis, 90, of East Jordan, will be held 11 a.m. Wednesday, April 4, at the Oak Chapel of the Vanderwall Funeral Home. Rev. Dr. Donald Ferguson of the First Presbyterian Church will officiate. Burial will be in Sunset Hill Cemetery.

Mrs. Davis died March 30, 1984, at Grandvue Medical Care Facility.

The former Gladys Hudkins was born Feb. 4, 1894, in East Jordan. She graduated from East Jordan High School in 1911 and taught at Wildwood Harbor, Walloon Lake, prior to her marriage to Walter Davis on June 25, 1913. Mr. Davis preceded her in death in 1958.

Mrs. Davis was a member of the First Presbyterian Church, the Order of Eastern Star; a member and

past national officer in the Rural Letter Carriers Auxiliary and chairman of the Charlevoix County March of Dimes for many years.
