Julius Leroy Metcalf, 75, of East Jordan, died Nov. 14, 1992, at Charlevoix Area Hospital.

Funeral will be 11 a.m. Wednesday, Nov. 18, at the Paullin Funeral Home in East Jordan with the Rev. David Downton of the First Presbyterian Church in East Jordan officiating. Interment will follow in Sunset Hill Cemetery, East Jordan.

He was born Nov. 26, 1916, in East Jordan, the son of Edgar Leroy and Elsie May (Crawford) Metcalf. He lived all of his life in East Jordan.

Mr. Metcalf served in the U.S. Army during World War II and received the Purple Heart and the Silver Star.
