Lewis James Barnard III, 5, of Bellaire, died June 7, 1986, in Eveline Township, Charlevoix County.

Funeral will be 11 a.m. Wednesday, June 11, at the Bellaire Community United Methodist Church. Officiating will be the Rev. Walter Kregler of the Bellaire Hope Lutheran Church, the Rev. Jim Wenger of the Feast of Victory Lutheran Church of Acme and the Rev. Scott McKinney, former pastor at the Feast of Victory Lutheran Church. Interment will be in Sunset Hill Cemetery, East Jordan.
